Dear friends and supporters of Trätro,
While I am waiting in Ethiopia for my connecting flight to Vienna, I am writing to report on the last three weeks in Mozambique 😊

- **Missionary Visa:** Unfortunately, I haven't managed to get my one-year missionary visa yet. My documents were sent from Berlin to Maputo and back to Berlin. I will try to obtain the visa there next week, potentially picking it up in person (including two overnight trips with Flixbus).
- **House Sale:** I finally received the money from our house sale two weeks ago and used it immediately to pay off a significant amount of debt 😊.
- **New Home:** Construction on our house in Mozambique is set to begin soon; I am looking forward to having a "nest" again. We are taking great care to build it in a way that helps us withstand the local heat.
- **The Heat:** Last weekend, we survived 40°C temperatures using showers, foot baths, and wet towels. Unfortunately, air conditioning only works with electricity, which was mostly unavailable during those two days... sweating!!

Relief Efforts and Maintenance



- **Flood Relief:** Last week, I was able to participate in a relief delivery for flood victims in a location with 2,000 affected people. Many had taken refuge in a school, but they now have to vacate it for the students.
- **Distribution:** We were greeted by about 200 people, and the local chief took over the fair distribution of clothing and food.

- **AVA Training Center:** We also had to carry out some renovations on our buildings at the AVA training center. While we didn't have flooding, many walls had mold because the massive rain fell almost horizontally.
- **Ventilation:** Additionally, there is often a lack of attention to ventilation, so I constantly have to remind people or do it myself.



- **Church Growth:** Our church attendance is growing steadily; 100 children already come on Sundays!
- **New Shelter:** Therefore, a shelter is currently being built so that the children's service doesn't have to take place under the blazing sun.

Clinic Rooms: Construction of two clinic rooms also began yesterday, sponsored by a team from the USA who plan to bring physical donations after Easter.

- **Classrooms:** At our own expense, we want to add an upper floor for new classrooms, as we are bursting at the seams.



Training: Since February, **126 (!) new course participants** have registered (pictured above at the first meeting), divided into electrician, tailoring, welding, and English courses.

About 30 of them pay a small contribution (approx. €8/month).

- **Employment:** Next week, some of our tailoring graduates will begin sewing school uniforms, as many needy people have already asked us for help. We are happy to be able to provide jobs to help many families.

We thank God and all of you for all the provision and for carrying us in your prayers!
